Criteria for Penalties Applicable under Item 2, Paragraph 1, Article 9 of the Aids to Navigation Act for the Maritime and Port Bureau, MOTC

Established in accordance with Order Hang-An No. 1102012219A dated October 22, 2021

- I. The Maritime and Port Bureau of the MOTC has specifically established these standards to exercise its administrative discretion power for penalties for violations of Article 9, Paragraph I, Item II of the Aids to Navigation Act while meeting the principle of proportionality, thereby protecting the people's rights and interests.

- II. See the appendix for the penalty standards of Article 9, Paragraph I, Item II of the Aids to Navigation Act.

Appendix

Violation Item	Penalty Basis	Penalty Standard
Vessels not taking the announced fairway in accordance with Article 8.	Article 10 Where a vessel violates Item II of Paragraph I of Article 9 for failing to take the designated fairway, the shipping administration authority shall impose a fine of not less than NT\$100,000 but not more than NT\$500,000 on the owner, charterer, master, his/her deputy in his/her absence, yacht skipper, boat skipper, or his/her deputy in his/her absence.	The first time: NT\$100,000. The second time: NT\$150,000. The third time: NT\$200,000. The fourth time: NT\$250,000. The fifth time: NT\$300,000. The sixth time: NT\$350,000. The seventh time: NT\$400,000. The eighth time: NT\$450,000. The ninth time and more: NT\$500,000. If an offender has not violated this regulation within the previous two years from the date of the offender's most recent violation, then the accumulated number of violations shall be restarted from one.
